Gentlemen:

In compliance with our repeated demands to plug the subject well in accordance with Order No. R-111-A and the Commission Rules and Regulations, action was taken by you on May 2 and 3, 1961, to drill out the existing plugs in the well and to fill it with cement from a depth of 1319 feet to 375 feet, as per Mr. Armstrong's instructions.

We are informed that in drilling out the subject well no cement plug was encountered at any depth around 400 feet even though a Form C-103 previously filed with the Commission stated that a 20-sack cement plug was placed at approximately 400 feet. This form, filed by Hobbs Pipe and Supply Co. as Agent for Henry Black Drilling Co., Inc. and signed by Mr. Stanley Saikin as Superintendent for Hobbs Pipe and Supply Co., showed that the work was performed on January 30, 1961.
