Gentlemen:

Commission Form C-103, Notice of Intention to clean out and install a new pump was approved July 15, 1965, on the above mentioned #1 well, and on August 31, 1965, on the #2 well. To date this office has not received the Subsequent Report on this work.

An allowable was assigned to the #2 well on the basis of a test dated 8-26 & 8-28-65. This allowable was cancelled on 12-2-65, for failure to file Form C-115, Operator's Monthly Report. We feel that since no production reports have been filed since September, 1965, for well #2 and an inspection of the wells reveal that nothing has been done to put well #1 on production that these wells should be plugged and abandoned immediately.
