Gentlemen:

Please find enclosed herewith your approved copy of Form C-101 Notice of Intention to Drill the State "A" No. 1 well in NE SW Sec. 36-19S-30E (Undesignated location) Eddy County, New Mexico.

You will note that I have made an exception to your 8 5/8" casing to conform with request of Potash Company of America, as set out in their waiver, also this explains the delay in my approval of your Form C-101 as we were waiting to receive the waiver from the Potash Lessee.

Also you will note that we have classified your well site as undesignated instead of Hackberry-Yates Pool. The Hackberry-Yates Pool embraces the SE 1/4 of Sec. 36 as presently defined by the Commission, therefore in event you make a well (and we hope you do) it will be necessary for you to request a pool extension by filing form C-123 in duplicate with the Proration Manager Box #2045, Hobbs, New Mexico.

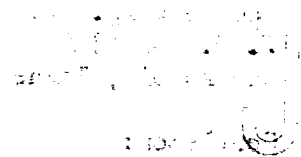
