The proposed procedure to P&A is as follows:

1. Dump 3 sxs cmt on top of CIBP @ 3127'.
2. Set 25 sx cmt plug from 2000'-1900'.
3. Cut off 5 1/2" casing & pull. (estimated 1000' recovery).
4. Set 45 sx cmt plug 50' in and 50' out of casing stub.
5. Set 60 sx cmt plug from 877'-777'.
6. Perf 8 5/8" casing @ 200' & set cmt retainer @ 190'.
7. Pump 125 sxs cmt through retainer & circ outside 8 5/8" casing to surface.
8. Set 20 sx cmt surface plug.
