*** 8 5/8" csg set at time well originally drilled. This well was abandoned 4-14-49. It was not considered to be a commercial producer at the time it was drilled. Results of fracture treatments in the field indicate the well would be a commercial producer if fractured instead of shot as was the practice at the time the well was originally drilled. It is intended to re-enter the old hole, drill out the plugs**

Approved **run 7" casing and fracture in open hole.**
