

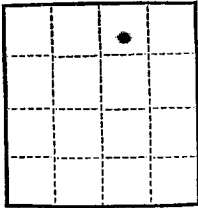

DETAILS OF WORK

We will set approximately 800' of 8 5/8" casing and cement with not less than 100 sacks of cement. We will then drill to approximately 4250 feet and set 5 1/2" casing and cement with not less than 1,200 sacks of cement. We will then perforate the Queen section and complete the well through perforations in the zone between 3,300 and 3,700 feet.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

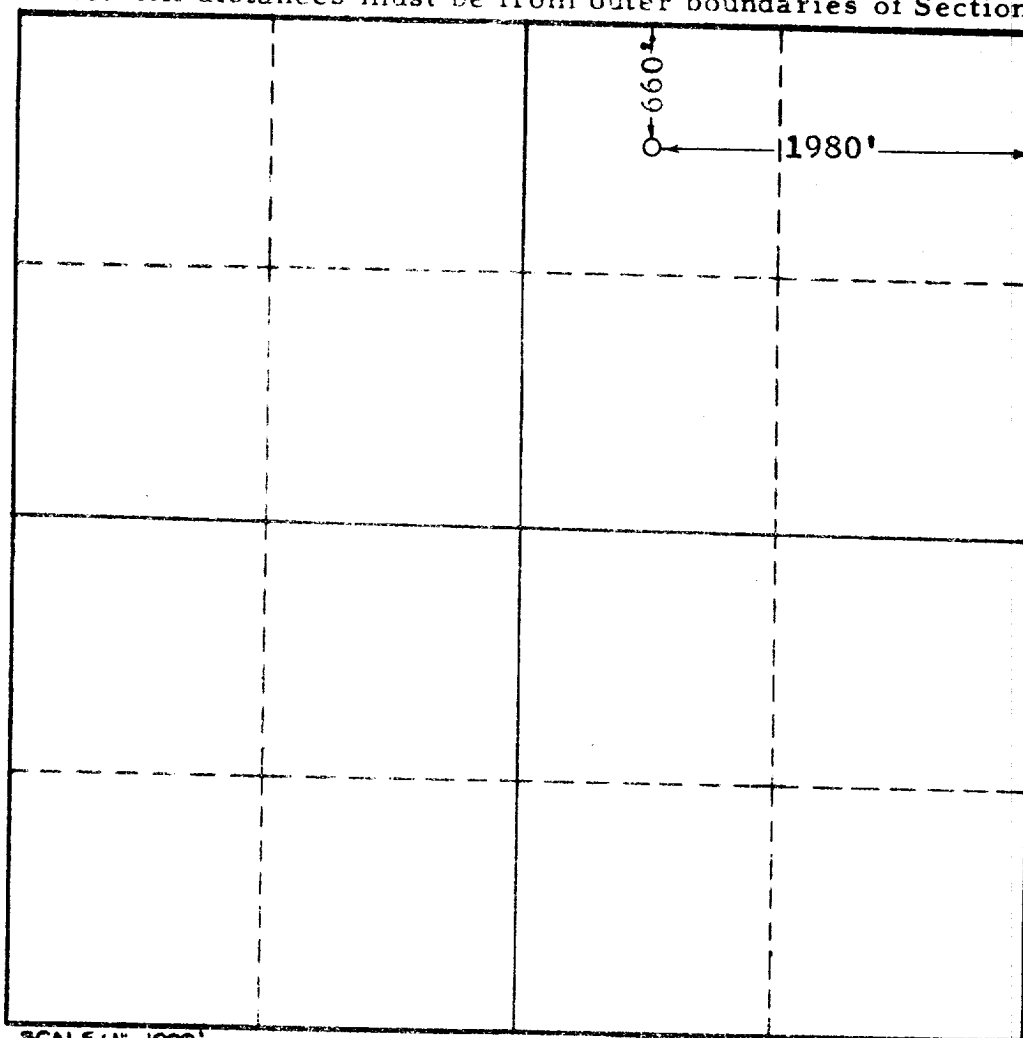
