Gentlemen:

In accordance with the provisions of Commission Order R-1355, the North Shugart-Grayburg Pool is abolished and the vertical limits of the North Shugart-Queen Pool are extended to include the Grayburg formation and renamed the North Shugart-Queen-Grayburg Pool.

Consequently, your Federal Johnson B ac/2 #1 oil well in Unit D of Section 15, Township 18 South, Range 31 East, which is currently listed in the North Shugart-Grayburg Pool in the Proration Schedule, will appear in the North Shugart-Queen-Grayburg Pool in the May Schedule.

Please file Form C-110 with the Artesia office of the Oil Conservation Commission showing the change in pool designation.
