DETAILS OF WORK

At total depth 1,010 ft., plugged back depth 3,900 ft. the well was plugged and abandoned as follows on Sept. 14, 1958.  
 Set cement plug on bottom of perforations @ 3713 ft. with 10 sack cement and 1 sack calceol, mudded hole back up to surface. Knocked pipe off @ 3056 ft. and pulled same, circulated mud to the surface. Set 10 sack plug on the stub of 5 1/2 inch cas. set 10 sack plug below base of salt 1750 ft., 10 sack plug @ shoe joint 1-5/8" cas. (710 ft.), set cement plug at 371 ft. (stub of 2-5/8" cas), set plug @ surface, set regulation marker, cleaned location and filled pits. The location is now ready for inspection.

The plugging was done by Artesia Casing Packers, Artesia, N.M., and witnessed by Robert F. Evans, representative of the U. S. G. S.
