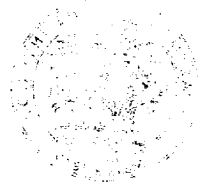

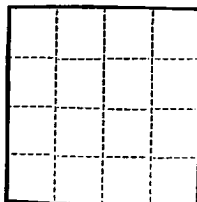

**DETAILS OF WORK**

We propose to drill to a total depth of approximately 3600 feet with rotary tools and complete in the Queen formation. The casing program will be as follows: 7-5/8 inch 24#, H-40 surface casing to be set @ 740 feet and cemented with 200 sacks. Cement will be circulated to surface. 4-1/2 inch 9.5#, J-55 casing set @ 3200 feet & cemented with 150 sacks cement.
