The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 3636 ft.

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Propose to plug well by filling with heavy mud from the bottom of the 7" pipe, set at 3455 feet, to total depth at 3740 feet. Run ten (10) sacks of cement as a plug at 3455 feet. After Recovering as much 7" pipe as possible a ten (10) sacks cement plug will be placed at 7" pipe stub. A ten (10) sacks cement plug will be placed at bottom of 8 5/8 pipe at 787 feet, recoverable 8 5/8 pipe to be pulled. Intervals between plugs to be filled with heavy mud. Regulation marker to be cemented at surface. This well produced 31 Oct 1947 to 31 May 1948 a total of 269 barrels of oil, about 1 1/4 barrels of oil per day; net value of the oil sold for the 7 months was 527.00 dollars, which was less than the cost of operating maintenance and extra expenses.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
