We propose to drill well at above location to approximately 4000' or commercial production at a lesser depth. Set 8 5/8" 24 lb. casing in top of salt as approximately 650' and cement with 50 sacks. Test the Yates sand at approx. 2650' and if tests warrant will run 7" O.D. casing through section, cement with 100 sacks and complete well in Yates. If the Yates will not warrant completion will drill through the queen section at approx. 4000'. set 3 1/2" casing and cement back above the Yates and complete same.

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I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
