Gentlemen:

We have been informed by the office of V. S. Welch, at Artesia, that Yates, Seven Rivers, Queen and Grayburg are co-mingled in the captioned area. Thus, only one allowable is allocated to a 40-acre tract. Kenwood Oil Company had previously drilled their #4 Shugart "A" well on the captioned tract. Said well is producing from the Queen Formation. On December 12, 1963, Kenwood Oil Company made a farmout of this tract to V. S. Welch as to the deeper rights.

Recent tests show the Kenwood #4 Shugart "A" is capable of producing only 5 barrels oil per day. We have been advised by Mr. Welch's office that a letter to you, requesting the Kenwood #4 Shugart "A" be given an allowable of 5 barrels oil per day and the balance of the 40acre allowable be allocated to the Welch #3 Kenwood Federal, would be sufficient to enable Welch to produce the #3 Kenwood Federal.

This formula is satisfactory with Kenwood Oil Company, and is to remain in effect until such time as you may be differently advised by Kenwood.
