Gentlemen:

Subject well was approved for a dual completion (tubingless) by Administrative Order MC-1066 dated June 5, 1961. Upon drilling the well to the top of the Queen formation, it was determined that the proposed lower pay (Queen-Grayburg) was non-commercial. It was necessary to use only one string of 2 7/8" OD casing to effect a single (tubingless) completion in the pay of the Culwin-Yates Pool.


The well has now been completed and potentialled. Details of the work are shown on Forms C-103 and C-105.

Similar circumstances in the proposed and actual conditions of completion occurred on our N. M. State "T" No. 2.

Please advise if any further data or procedure is necessary for approval of this well.
