**R E C E I V E D**

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**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**  
**OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION**

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) Westwater Corporation made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on November 17, 1960, for permission to dually complete its State "32" Well No. 1 located in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 31 East, EMM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from the Yates formation adjacent to the Shugart Pool and the production of oil from the Grayburg formation adjacent to the North Shugart-Queen Grayburg Pool.

Now, on this 22nd day of November, 1960, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'e' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That waivers of objection have been received from all offset operators and that the waiting period prescribed by Rule 112-A may be dispensed with at this time.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

That the applicant herein, Westwater Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its State "32" Well No. 1 located in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 31 East, EMM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from the Yates formation adjacent to the Shugart Pool and the production of oil from the Grayburg formation adjacent to the North Shugart-Queen Grayburg Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

**PROVIDED HOWEVER,** That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section

Under the provisions of Rule 115-A (c) Masterser Corporation  
made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on  
November 17, 1960, for permission to quarry compresses in Section  
"35" MEXICO. I located in the NW 1/4 of Section 35, Township  
18 South, Range 31 East, New Mexico, in such a  
manner as to permit the production of oil from the  
adjacent to the Sandpit pool and the North Sandpit-Oneen Grayspar  
grayscale formation adjacent to the North Sandpit-Oneen Grayspar  
pool.

Now, on this 25th day of November, 1960, the Secretary  
Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions  
of sub-section 'c' of Rule 115-A of the Commission's Rules and  
Regulations;

(2) That administrative information has been provided by the  
operator of oil lease sold by said

(3) That witness to docketed by Rule  
officer operator and that the witness being presented by Rule  
115-A may be disregarded with the time.

(4) That the proposed unit will not cause waste  
nor impair conservation rights.

(5) That the mechanics of the proposed unit conservation are  
described and concurring with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application herein, Masterser Corporation, be and the  
same is hereby granted to quarry compresses in Section "35" MEXICO.  
I located in the NW 1/4 of Section 35, Township 18 South,  
Range 31 East, New Mexico, in such a manner as  
to permit the production of oil from the State formation adjacent  
to the Sandpit pool and the North Sandpit-Oneen Grayspar  
pool for the purpose of rapid  
removal of surplus.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That application shall conserve, otherwise,  
any produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section

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V. Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER: That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual GOR Test Period for the North Shugart-Queen Grayburg Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order, the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-zone production in the interests of conservation.
