13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations (Clearly state all pertinent details, and give pertinent dates, including estimated date of starting any proposed work. On 6/30/93, we began operations to cleanout the wellbore in this existing well. We pulled the rods and tubing and ran in the hole with a bit and casing scraper. We drilled through scale to the TD of 3840'. We spotted scale remover to dissolve the scale. A slotted liner was run from 3424'-3837'. The formation was acidized with 3000 gals 15% NE Pad Acid (10% zylene) and 2200 lbs rock salt diverter. We swabbed back the load and ran production equipment. The well was returned to production and pump tested for several days. Currently, the well is making 8 BOPD and 84 BWPd.

On 6/9/93, our district engineer Randy Jackson discussed this procedure with Shannon Shaw of the BLM in Carlsbad. Mr. Shaw determined that we did not need to submit a Notice of Intent for this workover, only a Subsequent Report.
