- 4114¹' - 4116' Fine, tight gray sandstone. Scattered oil staining.
- 4120' Cores missing.
- 4122' Dense, crystalline, brownish gray dolomitic limestone. Rare spots of oil staining.

Drilling samples.

- 4120' - 4125' White non-crystalline limestone & light to medium gray to brownish gray, granular crystalline dolomitic limestone.
- 4130' Light to medium to brownish gray, granular crystalline dolomitic limestone.

Circulated (30 minutes) sample

- 4130' Light to medium to brownish gray, dense, granular crystalline dolomitic limestone.

Note: The basal portion of the core and the drilling samples from 4120' to 4130' appear to indicate that the depth of 4120' represents the top of the so-called Grayburg formation.
