Lease Terminated by Operation of Law. Bond Liability Terminated.

Oil and gas lease, Las Cruces O61609 (formerly part of example ehange lease O29311, dated December 31, 1938), stands of record in the name of A. J. Hardendorf and covers the ME2 sec. 6, T. 19 8., R. 31 K., N.M.P.M. in the Culwin Field, New Mexico. Because of discovery and production from the leasehold the lease was in its secondary term co-terminous with the period of production.

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The Goological Survey has reported that the one well drilled on the loase produced continuously until June 1947, when the last shipment of oil was made, and that subsequently the well was satisfactorily plugged and abandoned in accordance with the operating regulations. The lossee has indicated his ascent to the termination of the losse. The losse account is in good standing.

In view of the eccention of production, the lease is deemed to have terminated by operation of law on June 30, 1947, the last day of the lease month in which there was production.

The case record contains a \$5000 bond executed August 22, 1945, by the lessee, as principal, and American Employers' Insurance Company, by J. S. Ward, attorney in fact, surety. In view of the termination of the lesse and satisfactory abandonment of the well, liability under the bend is terminated as of June 30, 1947.
