Gentlemen:

Mr. Foster in the Lovington office of Texas-New Mexico Pipe Line Company advised us by telephone July 23, 1964, that they had not received an official proration allowable and could not take any more oil from the above captioned wells until they received approved Form C-115 and until they had been assigned a number (?) by your office.

Mr. Foster also said that they had made an unauthorized run from each of these wells this month, but had cleared these with the Oil Conservation Commission. These are old wells, have been on the regular proration sheet for several years, and we are not aware of any irregularities.

Mr. Armstrong of your office in Artesia was contacted this morning and he suggested that we write to you requesting information as to what procedure should be taken to straighten out this situation.

Any information that you can give us will be greatly appreciated.
