If upon receipt of this letter you are still unable to assign an allowable to our well, we would appreciate hearing from you.

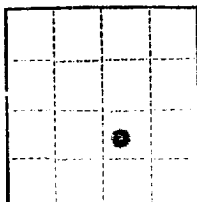
