Reference is made to your notice of Intention to Drill dated July 21, 1959, covering your No. 1-21-Tennessee Federal well in the NE1/4 sec. 21, T. 19 S., R. 31 E., N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico. The well location is within the Potash Area designated by order of the Secretary of the Interior dated October 16, 1951.

Pursuant to authority delegated to the Oil and Gas Supervisor by the Director of the Geological Survey on July 30, 1959, to approve the drilling of the above mentioned well, I hereby approve your proposed drilling subject to compliance with the provisions of the Oil and Gas Operating Regulations revised May 25, 1942, a copy of which will be sent to you on request, and subject to the following conditions:

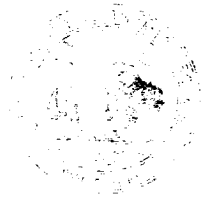
1. Such drilling operations shall not exceed a depth of 5000 feet.
2. Drilling operations are subject to the attached sheet for general conditions of approval.
3. Notify the District Engineer, U.S. Geological Survey, Artesia, New Mexico in sufficient time to arrange for a representative to witness cementing operations and water shut-off test.
