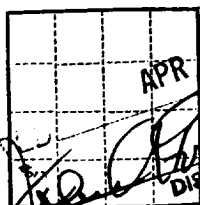

DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill to total depth of approximately 2100' in the Yates Line with cable tools. 8-5/8" casing will be set and cemented at 830' with cement returned to surface. 7" casing will be cemented at approximately 2050'.

Casing - 8-5/8" 20' J-55 New
 7" 20' J-55 New

This well to be drilled in conformity with special rules and regulations governing such operations within the Pecos Area and as approved for the drilling of Well No. 1 March 18, 1954, which well was plugged and abandoned at 250' and rig moved 20 ft south of old location to this proposed location to be drilled.

Conditions of approval to drill subject well shall comply with approval to drill well No. 1-Adams, approval letter dated March 18, 1954.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
