Abandonment of well is planned due to lack of ability to produce oil in commercial quantities. Well has 8-5/8" surface casing at 655' cemented with 150 sacks, 4-1/2" casing at 1970' with 125 sacks and is perforated in the Yates formation from 1940' to 1970'. Well will be loaded with heavy mud and both strings of casing cut at the free point. Cement plugs will be set as follows:

15 sacks from 1970 to 1800 ft.
35 sacks across top of cut-off 4-1/2" casing
35 sacks from 700 to 600 ft.
15 sacks in top of hole with regulation marker.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
