Re-commenced producing operations on May 1, 1966. Recovered 20 barrels of oil. Well produced at rate of 2 BOPD. On May 4, 1966, commenced abandoning well per USGS approval as follows:

Set 15 sack plug on bottom 1970 to 1800 ft.
Shot off 1100' of 4-1/2" casing and pulled.
Set 35 sack plug 1200' to 1000'.
Set 35 sack plug from 700 to 600'.
Set 15 sacks cement in top of hole, with regulation marker.

Completed plugging May 8, 1966. Location is clean and ready for inspection.

Instructions

Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
