STATEMENT OF THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY

The following statement was made by the Secretary of the New York State Conservation Commission at a public hearing held on the 10th day of May, 1962, at the New York State Capitol, Albany, New York, in response to questions asked by the members of the Senate Committee on Conservation and Forestry.

The Commission has been authorized by the Legislature to conduct a study of the conservation of the State's natural resources, including the State's forests, and to report the results of its study to the Legislature.

The Commission has held several public hearings on this subject, and has received many suggestions from the public. The Commission is now in the process of preparing a report on its findings and recommendations, and expects to submit it to the Legislature in the near future.

The Commission is very grateful for the interest and assistance of the members of the Senate Committee on Conservation and Forestry, and for the public's interest in the conservation of the State's natural resources.
