Moved in and rigged up H. L. McFarland rotary tools. Spudded well at 9:15 A.M. 11/28/64. Drilled 12-1/4" hole to 917' and hole deviated from 3° at 700' to 7-1/4° at 900'. Spotted 175 sx Incon cement plug from 830-570'. Dressed off cement plug to 712' and set 10-1/4" OD whipstock. Started new hole at 712' with inclination of 1-1/2°. Drilled 12-1/4" hole to 1076'. Ran 33 jts 9-5/8" OD SR 32.30s H-40 STAG casing, guide shoe & float collar = 1060.32'. Set at 1072.32' HAS. Cemented w/200 sx Incon + 4% gel, 12-1/2"/sk gilsonite & 1/4"/sk floccle. Cementing basket at 608'. Plug down at 7:15 P.M. 12/11/64. Cement did not circulate. Ran 1" line pipe beside 9-5/8" casing and found top of cement at 297'. Pumped in 350 sx Incon neat + 2% CaCl and filled up to 168'. Pumped in two 20 sk batches of 3:1 Incon-Calseal cement and filled up to 120'. Circulated cement to surface w/130 sx of Incon neat + 2% CaCl. Job complete at 5:30 A.M. 12/12/64. Installed casinghead, BOP's and air head. Tested 8-5/8" casing to 1000' for 30 minutes. Held O.K. and job complete at 7:00 P.M. 12/12/64. Drilled floats and air drilled 8-3/4" hole to 1078'. Well dusted below casing shoe.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations.
