A hydraulic pump was installed 3/5/65 and started producing from the Canyon perforation. Took off production 6/17/65. Pumped at rate of approximately 8 MO and 264 MGD before taking off pump.

6/21/65 - Set bridge plug at 6970. Perf 6730-6735 with 2 JPF. Acidized with 500 gal. mud acid. Swabbed 8 bbls. salt water per hour with a little gas.

6/24/65 - Squeezed perms 6730-6735 with 50 sxs.

6/25/65 - Perf 5568-5570, 2 JPF and 5578-5582 2 JPF. Set packer at 5552 and acidized with 500 gal. reg. acid, swabbed dry, all show oil.

6/28/65 - Reacidized perms 5568-5570 and 5578-5582 with 2000 gal. acid, swabbed down, no increase of fluid over previous treatment.

Perf. with 2 JPF at following depths 6193, 6205, 6222 & 6230 and perf. interval 5494-5499 with 2 JPF. Set packer above lower set at approximately 6150' and acidized with 2000 gal. Swabbed back load and had a small volume of gas.

6/30/65 - Treated interval 5494-5499 through annulus by placing packer at 5535 approximately. Acidized with 500 gal. reg. acid. Swabbed back.

7/1/65 - Shut down.

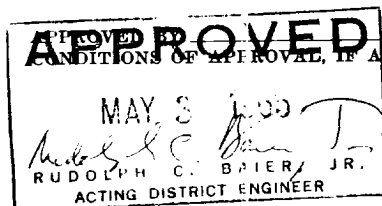

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
