Moved in and rigged up Capitan Drilling Company, Odessa, Texas, rotary tools. Spudded well at 3:30 P.M. 1/30/67. Drilled 12-1/4" hole to 773' RKB. (Top of anhydrite at 717' by samples.) Ran 24 jts of 8-5/8" OD 8R 24# J-55 ST&C new casing w/guide shoe and float collar = 756.50'. Set @ 767.65' RKB. Cemented w/237 sx Incor + 4% gel + 1/4#/sk Flocele + 2% CaCl. Tailed in w/200 sx Incor neat + 2% CaCl. Plug down @ 9:00 P.M. 1/31/67. Cement circulated. WOC 18 hrs. Ran bit & tested BOP's & 8-5/8" casing to 900# for 30 minutes. Held OK. Resumed drilling - 7-7/8" hole.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
