Drilled 2 1/2" hole with rat hole machine to 10' below bottom of cellar. Cemented 20" conductor pipe with 2 yards of ready mix to surface.

McVay Drilling Company spudded 17-1/2" hole at 10:00 PM, January 26, 1967. Drilled to 712'. Ran 20 joints, 620' of 13-3/8" H-40 L&L STAC and 2 joints, 64' of 13-3/8" S-55 61# STAC casing. Set and cemented at 704' with 275 sacks of class C with 16% gel, 2% salt, .1% H-F and 130 sacks of class C with 2% Ca Cl2. Cement circulated. WOC & NU 22 hours. Tested casing with 1000#, 30 minutes. OK.

Started drilling 11" hole at 712' at 4:45 AM, January 30, 1967.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures, and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
