We do not have all the deviation surveys required by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission. The condition is the result of either the surveys not being taken or were lost.

The dip of the San Andres and Yeso section in this area is probably a degree or less, based on subsurface mapping of structure. This and the fact that there are no significant changes in the stratigraphic section in this well compared to other nearby wells, is evidence that the hole deviation in the unsurveyed part of the hole is probably of low order, similar to the attached deviation surveys.

The nearest well to the Greasewood "BD" No. 1 is the Yates Petroleum Corporation, Johnston "BE" No. 1, Section 8-195-25E, 330' FNL & 330' FEL. The required deviation survey's were run on this well and the survey's ranged from 1/2 to 1-1/2 degree in magnitude.
