Dear Mr. Nutter:

As per your request by telephone on September 20, 1968, I am submitting complete details, concerning the completion of the subject well, located 1980' FNL, 660' FEL, of Section 15-T19S-R25E, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Pertinent well data information is as follows:

1. 13-3/8" casing is set at 110' with cement circulated to the surface.
2. 9-5/8" casing is set at 1200' with cement circulated, conforming to regulation for setting 100' below any Artesian Aquifer, and witnessed by District Representative for New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.
3. 8-3/4" hole drilled to Total Depth of 9416' into top of the Mississippian.

As approved per telephone it is the plan of Yates Petroleum Corporation to run 2-7/8" J-55 New Tubing to total depth of 9416'.

1. To test all tubing to 6500 psi going in hole.
2. To centralize tubing at 60' intervals with 2-7/8" x 7 1/2" wrap around centralizers from 9416' to 8700'.
3. To cement 2-7/8" tubing from 9416' back to 8000' with 500 sacks of Class "C" Incor plus proper additives.
