Moran Drilling Company drilled 8-3/4" hole to TD at 9054'. San logs. Bond log showed top of cement outside 9-5/8" surface casing at 748'. Plugged and abandoned as follows: Spotted 50 sack Class H Neat cement plug No. 1 from 8900' to 8760'; 50 sack Class H Neat cement plug No. 2 from 6985' to 6845'; 50 sack Class H Neat cement plug No. 3 from 5105' to 4965'; 50 sack Class H Neat cement plug No. 4 from 3005' to 2865' and 50 sack with 4% gel and 2% Ca Cl2 cement plug No. 5 from 940' to 846', across bottom of 9-5/8" casing at 898'. WOC 4 hours. Checked plug at 846', OK. Loaded casing with water. Perforated 9-5/8" casing from 340' to 342' with 1/2" JHPT. Squeezed perforations with 100 sacks of Class C cement with 4% gel, 1% Ca Cl2 and 1/4" floccle per sack and 50 sacks Class C with 4% gel and 1/2" Ca Cl2. Checked plug at 117'. Loaded hole with water and tested with 1000', 30 minutes, OK. Washed green cement from 270' to 329'. WOC 3-1/2 hours. Drilled hard cement to 342', stringers to 350' and no cement to 360'. Tested perforations 340' to 342' with 240', OK. All tests and cementing witnessed by Mr. Charles Saunders with U. S. G. S. in Artesia. Set 25 sack cement plug from 40' to surface. Installed dry hole marker. Plugged and abandoned April 2, 1969.

Instructions
