This well swabbed mostly water after open hole section from 2259'-2314' was fractured with 25,000 gallons of jelled water and 25,000 lbs. of sand. At this time we are in the process of transferring this lease to another operator and he has requested that we not plug and abandon this well as it is his desire to do further testing after the property has been assigned to him. With the increase in the price of oil it is possible sufficient oil can be recovered to make it economical to produce at this time. We therefore ask approval for T. A. until transfer of the property has been completed and the new operator has had an opportunity to make such tests.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
