Available mud logs and sample logs show the Strawn Sand member to be composed of clear to gray medium to coarse grained sand and angular chert and limestone fragments. This is indicative of a debric flow environment.

To date only two wells have produced from the "Strawn Sand," the Penroc Oil Corporation No. 1-A Dero Federal Com., located 35N, T-19S, R-28E, produced 1,110,176 MCFG and 30,722 barrels of oil from this interval before being abandoned. The Hillin Production Co. No. 2-1 JCW State located 2C, T-20S, R-28E, produced 3,223,724 MCFG and 50,045 barrels of oil to June, 1997 and is currently producing from this zone. The attached map shows the probable areal extent of the pay zone and the relationship of the Strawn Sand to other pay horizons in the area are illustrated on the attached cross section.
