
Enclosed is your Form C-124 in quadruple in regard to the captioned well. This form is complete except that the actual date of initial delivery of gas is not inserted, nor is the "Is gas actually connected" filled in.

The purchaser, Southern Union Gas Company, plans on commencing the taking of gas any day but the exact date is not known today. Southern Union seems to think that this Form C-124 needs to be approved by the Oil Conservation Commission before they can move any gas and we do not know how you can approve same without the above mentioned omissions being completed in your form (that is, indicating if gas is actually connected and when deliveries began).

We are sending a copy of this letter and the Form C-124, as noted below, and unless you instruct us and/or Southern Union Gas Company otherwise, we would like to have them commence the gas deliveries and, when the Oil Conservation Commission has been sent the formal notice of the date same began, you can complete the form and approve same. Please let us and Southern Union know what needs to be done by us, if anything.
