Gentlemen:

UMC is in receipt of your notification of October 22, 1991, requesting repair of packer leakage demonstrated on previous packer leakage test. UMC desires to P&A the Atoka, the lower most zone in this well and attempt to restore production in the Upper Strawn zone. If we are unable to mechanically perform this operation, we plan to plug off the Strawn and abandon the well as shown on the attached form C-103.

The pressure required to pump in to the Atoka is 1200 PSI, lower than that required to inject into the Strawn. We plan to pressure up on the Strawn interval with a separate pump and squeeze off the Atoka interval while holding a higher pressure on the Strawn interval. This should stop any communication between the two zones and properly seal the Atoka reservoir in this wellbore.

The Joint Operating Agreement requires that UMC as operator, give notification to all Working Interest Owners 30 days prior to commencement of plugging or workover operations. Please grant us until January 6, 1991 to begin the aforementioned plugging and workover operations. If this is not an acceptable time frame please notify me at 1 (800) 899-9110.
