Yates Petroleum Corporation, 207 South Fourth Street, Artesia, N.M. 88210, has filed form C-108 (Application for Authorization to Inject) with the New Mexico Oil Commission seeking administrative approval for an injection well. The proposed well, which is called the State "CO" Corn #1, located 1980' FSL and 1980' FWL of Section 36, Township 19 South, Range 24 East of Eddy County, New Mexico, will be used for saltwater disposal only. Disposal water will be injected into the Devonian formation at a depth of 9950-10,400' with a maximum pressure of 1990 psi and a maximum rate of 6000 BPD. All interested parties opposing the afore mentioned must file objections or request for a hearing with the Oil Conservation Division, P.O. Box 2088, Santa Fe, N.M., within 15 days.
