A notice of incidents of noncompliance was received in this office on April 22, 1993, for the subject well. The gravity of the violation was classified as major with the violation being a faulty pressure vacuum thief hatch and vent line valve. J. D. Whitlock, Jr. of the BLM signed the notice. I contacted Mr. Whitlock and advised that the subject well was a marginal producer and before spending any more money on the subject well I wanted to do further testing to determine if the well was capable of better performance.

Last week I ran a bottom hole pressure bomb, and further to that have contacted operators of salt water disposals in the area to evaluate the potential for a disposal connection. Testing the well to the atmosphere may be necessary as more engineering data is gathered. I would like to request an extension of 90 days to gather the necessary data to evaluate the subject well.

Gas prices have been increasing and the future for escalating prices appears brighter than in the past. This could certainly be a significant factor in the economics of a workover operation.
