5.5" CASING WAS CEMENTED IN THE WELL AT 11,549'.

THE WELL WAS COMPLETED WITH PERFORATIONS AT
8895'-8902' IN THE WOLFCAMP FORMATION
AND AT 11,065'-11,090 IN THE MORROW FORMATION.

THE WELL SHOWS LAST PRODUCTION ON ONGARD STATE DATA
BASE SYSTEM TO HAVE BEEN FEBRUARY OF 1993.

THE WELL FAILED A PACKER LEAKAGE TEST CONDUCTED IN
OCTOBER OF 1996.

A LETTER WAS SENT TO I.T. PROPERTIES REQUESTING THE
WELL BE REPAIRED ON OCTOBER 30 1996 BY RAY SMITH OCD
FIELD REP 2

ON DECEMBER 4, 1998 A SECOND LETTER WAS SENT CERTIFIED TO
I.T PROPERTIES BY MIKE STUBBLEFIELD FIELD REP 2.
THIS LETTER REQUESTED THE DUAL COMPLETION WELL BE
EITHER REPAIRED, TA OR BE PROPERLY PLUGGED AND ABANDONED
IN ACCORDANCE TO RULE 202 B..
THIS CERTIFIED LETTER WAS RETURNED UNCLAIMED.

JANUARY 14, 1999 MIKE STUBBLEFIELD CALLED K.W. CHEN
AND REQUESTED THE WELL BE REPAIRED, TEMPORARY
ABANDONED OR PLUGGED.
AFTER THE PHONE CONVERSATION A FAX COPY OF THE PHONE
CONVERSATION WAS FAXED TO K.W. CHEN'S FAX MACHINE NUMBER.

MARCH 3, 1999 A E-MAIL LETTER WAS SENT TO RAND CARROLL
REQUESTING THE DRY STATE #1 BE PROPERLY PLUGGED TO PROTECT THE
ENVIRONMENT AND CORRELATIVE RIGHTS IN THE AREA.

A SHOWCAUSE HEARING WAS SCHEDULED ON JULY 13, 2000
AND WAS CONTINUED TO OCTOBER 5TH 2000.
