

Floristics

The local plant assemblage consists of a sparse ground cover consisting of Prosopis juliflora, Scherpogon sp., Eutierrezia sarothrae, and some unidentified Gramineae.

Cultural Resources

No cultural resources were encountered during this reconnaissance.

Recommendations

ACA recommends clearance for the proposed project and suggests that construction proceed without modification of plans.

Rose #2

Location

The proposed well pad measures 235 ft x 210 ft with an associated Reserve Pit that measures 165 ft x 120 ft. A 990 ft access road, 12 ft wide, connects an existent road. This is located in the:

1/4 SW 1/4 Section 13, T15S, R23E, Chaves County, New Mexico (BLM).
