Development plan to accompany "Applications to Drill, Federal Lease".
12-Point Plan.

1. EXISTING ROADS: See Plat (Exhibit A) Caliched road, county maintained.
2. PLANNED ACCESS ROADS: See Plat (Exhibit A) Natural Gas Pipeline right-of-way to fence in NE SW of Sec. 27, then west to location, all high dirt surface.
3. LOCATION OF WELLS: See Plat (Exhibit A) Exploration well in Federal Unit area.
4. LATERAL ROADS TO LOCATION: See Plat (Exhibit A) First well in Unit area, no lateral roads planned at this time.
5. LOCATION OF TANK BATTERY & FLOWLINES: See Plat (Exhibit C) On east side of pad, near access road.
6. LOCATION & TYPES OF WATER SUPPLY: See Plat (Exhibit A) Drilling water will be trucked from available drilling supply.
7. METHODS FOR HANDLING WASTE DISPOSAL: See Sketch (Exhibit C) Mud in reserve pits, waste & engine oil in trash pit.
8. LOCATION OF CAMPS: Not Applicable.
9. LOCATION OF AIRSTRIPS: Not Applicable.
0. LOCATION LAYOUT (rig, tanks, pits, racks, etc.): See Sketch (Exhibit C)
1. PLANS FOR RESTORATION OF SURFACE: Pits to be fenced until dry, then leveled. Upon abandonment, surface to be cleaned & smoothed to near original.
2. OTHER ENVIRONMENT INFORMATION: Hilly terrain with prairie grass, greasewood & cactus; yellow tops on rocky ground; eroded drainage pattern. Utilization of pipeline right-of-way and proposed access road would keep traffic away from cattle stock tanks and feeding areas.
