Re: Administrative application of February 19, 2002 (application reference No. pKRV0-205137458) for an unorthodox subsurface oil well location within the North Dagger Draw-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool for Southwest Royalties, Inc.'s existing Julie Com. Well No. 1 (API No. 30-015-21863) in the SE/4 NE/4 (Unit H) of Section 17, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Dear Mr. Keathly:

Your application as submitted for the Division's review is incomplete and is hereby *denied*.

You indicate this well is to be dedicated to a 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit within either the "North Dagger Draw (Upper Penn) North pool" or "N. Dagger Draw (Cisco Canyon". You never indicate the reason why such unorthodox subsurface location is being sought nor provide the required support data. You apparently are not aware that the "North Dagger Draw-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool (**15472**)" is governed under special rules that require 160-acre acre units. You also failed to mention that the North Dagger Draw-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool underlying the NE/4 of Section 17 was the subject of a rather controversial Examiner proceeding in 1992 and 1995 and how the three orders issued affect your request.
