RE: DHY State B # 1 L-11-19-28 API 30-015-21971 Idle Well: <u>Violation of Rule</u> 201. Open unlined pit contains fluid and oil. No fence or netting: Violation of Rule 18 & 105. Tank on location has leaked oil out on to location and run into pasture: <u>Violation of Rule 13 & 116</u>. No well sign: <u>Violation of Rule 103</u>.

Dear Sirs:

This second directive is to notify you that this well is still in violation of the above Rules.

On 11 June, 2002 a letter was sent notifying you on the violation of Rules. An inspection on 9-18-02 found no action had been taken.

In the event that a satisfactory response is not received to this letter of direction by 18 November,

**2002.** further enforcement will occur. Such enforcement may include this office applying to the Division for an order summoning you to a hearing before a Division Examiner in Santa Fe to show cause why you should not be ordered to permanently plug and abandon this well. Such a hearing may result in imposition of **CIVIL PENALTIES** for your violation of OCD rules.
