

Dear Sir:

Gulf Oil Corporation requests your approval to flare gas from the subject well for a period not to exceed 14 days. We would like to obtain representative samples of formation gas and condensate in preparation for the design and construction of condensate stabilization facilities and a portable gasoline plant. It is necessary to condition the well through a series of flow tests prior to sampling the produced fluids (API bulletin RP 44).

It appears that both the Morrow and Atoka reservoirs encountered in this well bore contain substantial reserves of both gas and condensate. We have plans to drill several additional wells in the area and feel that this initial flaring of gas is justified to prevent future waste from the pool. The U. S. G. S. has verbally approved our application to flare gas for this period of time.
