- ✓ 1. All pits have been filled and leveled.
- ✓ 2. All pits and cellar have been filled and leveled.
- ✓ 3. A marker 4' in diameter and approximately 4' above ground level has been set in concrete. It must show the quarter section or unit designation, section, township and range. These have been permanently stenciled or welded on the marker.
- ✓ 4. The location has been leveled as nearly as possible to original ground contour and has been cleared of all junk and debris.
- ✓ 5. All fences and tie downs have been cut and removed.
- ✓ 6. If a well lease or last remaining well on lease, the pump pit locations have been leveled and cleared of all

These are minimum requirements and no plugging bond will be required. All wells for plugged and abandoned wells have been inspected and found
