In conjunction with form 9-3310, Application for Permit to Drill subject well, Texas Oil & Gas Corp. submits the following non items of pertinent information in accordance with USGS requirements:

1. The geologic surface formation is alluvium and bison deposits.
2. The estimated tops of geologic markers are as follows:

Top of Mississippian limestone, Woodford Shale and Devonian will be determined if we elect to test the Devonian. Additional information on Pennsylvanian tops will be available at that time to determine the deeper tops.

3. The estimated depths at which anticipated water, oil or gas formations are expected to be encountered:
 Water approximately 10970'.
 Oil or gas from approximately 10960' to 10970'.
 Shallow approximately 11320' to 11330'.
4. Proposed casing program: See Form 9-3310.
5. Pressure control equipment: See Exhibit D.
6. Mud program: See Form 9-3310.
7. Auxiliary equipment: Blowout preventer, inside blowout preventer, safety cock.
8. Testing, logging and coring programs:
