This plan is submitted with the Application For Permit to Drill the above described well. The purpose of this plan is to describe the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the magnitude of necessary surface disturbances involved, and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after completion of the operation so that a complete appraisal can be made of the environmental effects associated with the operation.

1. Existing Roads:

- A. Existing roads in the vicinity of planned well are shown on the attached Exhibit "A". The well is located approximately 19 miles South, Southeast of Hope, New Mexico. To reach the location, from Carlsbad go towards Artesia for 15 miles. Turn West on Seven Rivers blacktop road. Go 3 miles, turn right on county maintained caliche road and go 7 miles. Road forks, bear to the right and go 2.4 miles. Come to a fence and follow the arrow and continue for 1 mile. Location is 225' on the left hand side of the road.
- B. An existing road runs within 225' of the proposed well. Some grading and caliche will be required on this road.

2. Planned Access Roads:

- A. Since an existing road is close by, it will be utilized with a new road being built as indicated in RED in Exhibit "A" approximately 225' long.

No new gates or cattleguards are required.

3. Location of Existing Wells:

- A. There are no existing wells with a one mile radius, as shown by the circle on Exhibit "B".

4. Location of Existing and/or Proposed Facilities:

- A. There is no production equipment on this lease at present. If production is established, a tank battery will be built on the the drilling pad and no additional surface disturbance will occur.
