Report on Tres Amigos Well

5/24/80: Well had 4" in tank this morning. TP 500# Choke 12/64"  
5/25/80: Had 1' in tank. TP 250#. Choke 12/64". Reset to 16/64".  
5/26/80: Had 2'9" in tank (blew down to 2'4" - blew 5"). TP 50#. Reset choke to 1/16. At midnight the well had died and I shut it in. Couldn't gauge because batteries were down in flashlight.

5/27/80: Well had 3'1" this AM. After being SI had 700# TP. -Choke on 14/64", pressure going down. Worked with well all morning. Reset choke to 12/64", well still going down. Reset to 11/64", and well still going down. Reset to 10/64" choke and TP down to 300#.

Will check well later tonight when I get off work. Probably around midnight.

Well is not hooked up. Not selling gas. Separator is plugged off. I am guessing the well on this 10/64" choke is making approximately 40 MCF.

I think we are going to have to put an intermitter on it.

5/28/80: At 12:30 AM (shortly after midnight) well set on 10/64" choke, 250# TP. Reset to 11/64" choke. TP 150#. No fluid produced at 7:00 AM when I rechecked. Changed choke to 14½/64". Between roughly 7 and 11+ (approximately 4 to 5 hours) the well made 2" fluid, TP 150#. Well flowing good and seems to be holding on the 150# TP.

5/29/80: No report.

5/30/80: On 20/64" choke, made approximately 16 BO and increase in gas. 50 psi flowing pressure.

5/31/80: No report.

6/01/80: 4' in tank. 50# FTP. Set choke on 21/64", 22/64", and left on 24/64" choke.

6/02/80: Made 2" (apprx. 5 bbls). FTP @ 25 psi. Shut well in 2hrs. TP inc. to 200 psi. Reset choke on 18/64"/

6/03/80: Well dead on arrival. Tried unloading - nothing happened. Shut well in. Will check again around midnight.

6/04/80: At 1:00 AM, after being SI 14 hours, well had 550# TP. Set choke on 17/64". This AM well had made no oil and TP down to 100#. Set choke on 25/64" and left. Well seemed to be trying to unload.
