- B. <u>Surfacing Material</u>: The new road will be surfaced with the necessary depth of caliche which will be watered, compacted and graded.
- C. Maximum Grade: Flat, less than one percent.
- D. Turnouts: None required.
- E. <u>Drainage Design</u>: New road will be crowned with drainage on both sides.
- F. Culverts: None required.
- G. Cut and Fills: None required.
- H. Gates, Cattle Guards: None necessary.
- 3. LOCATION OF EXISTING WELLS:
 - A. Existing wells in the immediate area are shown on Attachment "B".

4. LOCATION OF EXISTING AND/OR PROPOSED FACILITIES:

- A. There are no production facilities on this lease at the present time.
- B. If the proposed well is productive, all necessary production facilities will be located on the well pad and no additional surface disturbance will be necessary.
- 5. LOCATION AND TYPE OF WATER SUPPLY:
 - A. It is not contemplated that a water supply well be drilled. Water necessary for drilling operations will be purchased and hauled to the well site over existing and proposed roads.
- 6. SOURCE OF CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS:
 - A. Caliche will be hauled from a pit located on Federal land in the M_{\pm}^{1} of Sec. 25. This pit was archaeologically examined by Dr. J. Loring Haskell on 11-26-79. Caliche will be trucked over existing and proposed roads.
