ATTACHED TO AND MADE A PART OF OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION - REQUEST FOR ALLOWABLE AND AUTHORIZATION TO TRANSPORT OIL AND NATURAL GAS

The Charolette McKay Federal #1 well was converted to a Salt Water Disposal Well in 1992; therefore, the well does not produce oil or gas in any quantity. There is a certain amount of residual hydrocarbons that collects in the holding tanks prior to injection of the produced fluids into the well. These residual hydrocarbons remain suspended in the produced fluids after the production from the wells has been channeled through separators to separate the oil from the produced water.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) The applicant herein, McKay Oil Corporation is hereby authorized to complete its Charolette McKay Federal No. 1 located in Unit H of Section 25, Township 20 South, Range 24 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the Devonian formation at approximately 9690 feet to approximately 10,300 feet through 2 7/8 inch plastic lined tubing set in a packer located at approximately 9600 feet.
