occur on these soil indivdiuals. Observed specimens include: Opuntia Leptocaulis, Opuntia imbricata, Opuntia sp. (platyopuntia), Opuntia macrocentra, Echinocactus texensis, Echinocereus pectinatus, and Mammillaria sp.

Cultural Resources

No archaeological sites or isolated manifestations were recorded during this reconnaissance. A light scatter of burned- and firecracked caliche cobbles were noted in the southeastern corner of the location. Cultural properties are not associated with these remains. They are situated in the:
